Your Apprenticeship in Flooring Technology includes 11 Core units including:

- Work Safely
- Communicate in the Workplace
- Work in a Team
- Using Flooring Technology Sector Hand and Power Tools
- Receive and prepare floor covering materials for installation
- Plan and cost flooring technology work
- Establish and maintain a safe flooring technology work environment
- Make measurements and calculations
- Read and interpret work documents
- Handle dangerous goods/hazardous substances.

Once the core units are completed you will complete 14 stream specific (Carpet, Timber, Vinyl or Combined) units.

The majority of units will be assessed via practical demonstration on-site while working with your employer.
