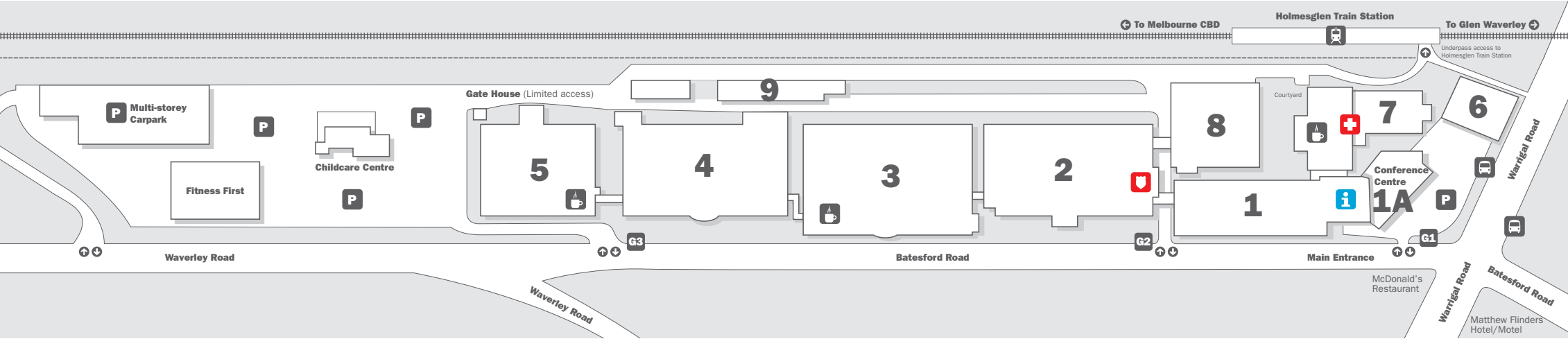

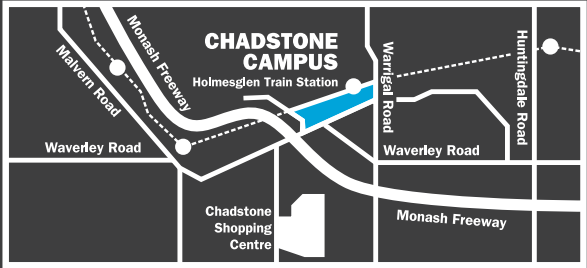
CHADSTONE CAMPUS PUBLIC TRANSPORT GUIDE
